### Competitions

The club runs 3 types of competitions.

**(G60m+10s)** Each player starts with 60 mins and receives an additional 10 seconds after every move. You must play all your moves within the time you have available. These events have 1 game each evening. These tournaments are rated on the Australian Chess Federation Ratings list.

**(G20m+10s)** Each player starts with 20 mins and receives an additional 10 seconds after every move. You must play all your moves within the time you have available. These events have 2 games per evening. These tournaments are rated on the Australian Chess Federation Rapid Ratings list.

**(G/5m)** Each player starts with 5 minutes. You must play all your moves within the time you have available. These events normally have 9 games each evening. These tournaments are not rated.

### Policy on byes

The club allows up to 2 half point byes per tournament (although not for the final round). If you are unable to play one of the rounds please contact the tournament director before the round (so as not to be included in the draw).

**Tournament Director:** The usual tournament director is Shaun Press (FIDE Arbiter).

**Junior players:** The club encourages junior players (Under 18) but for players Under 12 years of age, we request that a parent (or responsible guardian) remain at the club with them.

**Membership:** Membership is open to all ANU Staff, Students and invited guests (ie non ANU people). If you wish to join, just ask.

**Membership and tournament fees:** There is no charge for membership or for tournament entry. Any expenses that the club incurs (ACF/ACTCA fees, new equipment etc) will be met through a request for voluntary donations..
