

ANU High Schools/Colleges Chess Championship 2010

All High Schools and Colleges are invited to register a team of four players each to take part in the ANU High Schools/Colleges Chess Championship, part of the 18th ANU Chess Festival 2010.

High School/College teams to report to the Registration Desk, Great Hall, University House, Balmain Crescent, Acton by 9.00am on Friday 6 August 2010 (See map at <http://campusmap.anu.edu.au> and click on C-2. Building #1). Those teachers, coaches and parents who wish to stay whole day at the venue will be given a free parking voucher at the Registration Desk. Please ask for one when you arrive.

- The tournament will be a 7 round format for all ACT and Regional Schools.
- Tournament size is limited to 40 teams. Schools may enter any number of teams. Teams consist of 4 players and may also include 1 reserve player.
- Entry Fee of \$32 per team with Trophies and Medallions for prize-winners.
- Each player has 15 minutes for all their moves and chess clocks will be used. Matches will be played over 4 boards.
- Players are asked to bring their lunches, although meals are available for purchase in a cottage cafe in the Fellows Garden, University House. It is important that schools organise a parent or teacher to supervise their team(s).

* Team Manager: The students should be accompanied by a team manager (teacher or parent) who is responsible for them, and can look after their needs during the day.
